Students earn 1 credit per AS level course or a total of 2 credits per A level course upon passing the AICE exam. Students must earn a minimum of 7 credits, with at least 1 credit from each of Groups 1, 2, and 3. Students may use a maximum of 2 credits earned from Group 4, which is optional. AS Level Global Perspectives is required and earns a student 1 credit. AICE Psychology may be used to fulfill a Group 1 or a Group 3 requirement. Students must earn all credits within a 25-month window (three school years).
